

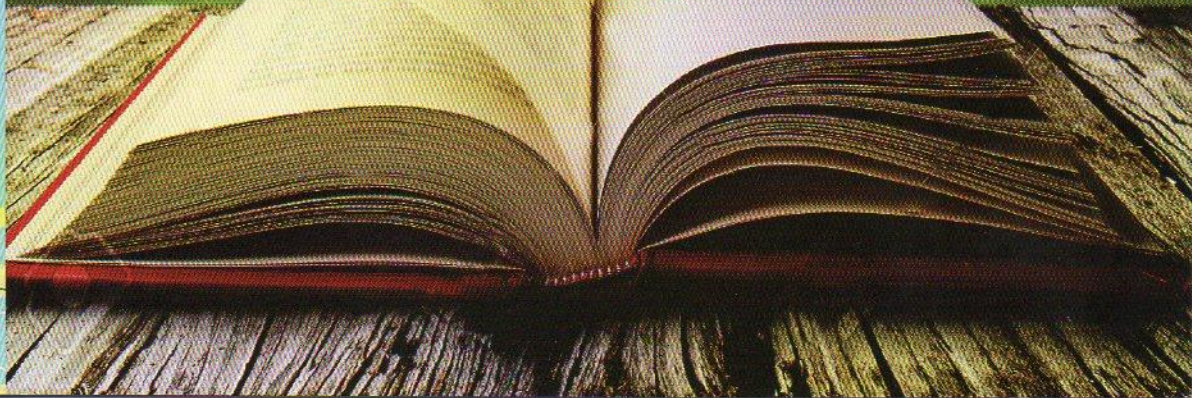

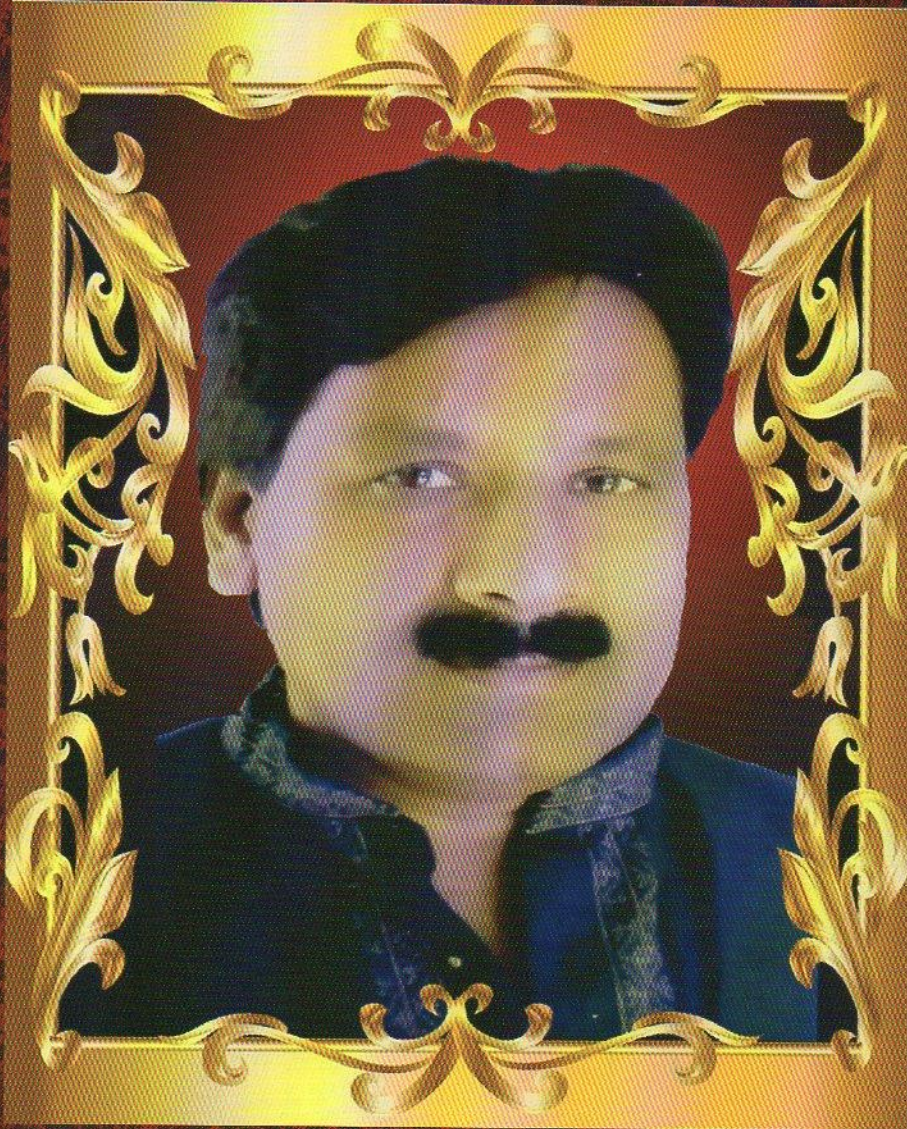

### **M.PHIL IN SOCIAL WORK PROGRAMME :-**

M. Phil. course is intended to prepare students for teaching and doctoral research and to enable them to appreciate the philosophical issues involved in understanding and intervening in social systems and the contemporary and future challenges confronting the society and professional social work.

### **Objectives of the M. Phil Course :-**

- A. To provide an advanced course of study to the post-graduates in Social Work
- B. To provide basic training required to undertaking doctoral research work and to prepare the students for undertaking independent research projects in areas of Social Work.
- C. To prepare the students for undertaking higher responsibilities in such areas as Social Work Education, research, policy formation, planning and administration.



M. Phil degree may be considered as Pre-Doctoral Course with emphasis on research methodology, teaching methods and advanced study of the subject. The endeavor would be to expose and sensitize the student to some recent and important issues in social work. The approach would be in the direction of promoting better comprehension of human problems, through a multidisciplinary perspective. Effort would be to delve into roots of issues and aspects under consideration, and their philosophical rational basis would be examined.

**Criteria for Eligibility : (Gondwana University Ordinance No. 164(2))**

Candidates who have passed in Master of Social Work Examination in not less than second division of the University or any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent thereto; or an equivalent Diploma in Social Work is not less than Second Division, Provided that candidate who are teachers in the University shall be given preference for admission to the course.

**A. Admission Procedure :-**

Application for admission in M. Phil. (Social Work) must be on the prescribed application form along with the Prospectus is supplied by the college, A non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 500/- is payable at the time of submission of the application form.

Attested true copies of the following certificates must be attached with the Application form and the originals must be produced at the time of the interview

- 1) Certificates of the last Qualifying examination (MSW)
- 2) Transfer/Leaving Certificate
- 3) Migration Certificate (for other University Students)
- 4) Eligibility Certificate (for other Uni. Students)
- 5) Caste Certificate & Caste Validity Certificate (If applicable)
- 6) Recent Passport size photographs (two in number)



### **B. Selection Procedure:-**

After scrutiny of the applications, the candidates will be called for written examination after the declaration of result of written examination candidate will be interviewed by a selection committee. The candidates performance at the post-graduation examination in Social work and in the interview, would be jointly considered before finalizing the list of candidates recommended for admission, canvassing in any form may lead to disqualification of the candidate. List of selected candidates will be displayed on the college notice board. Candidates who are employed would be required to attach Employment Certificate and No Objection Certificate from their head of institution.

The selected candidates must pay the required fees within the specified period.

The decision of the Principal, and co-ordinator of M.Phil. regarding admission shall be final candidates must make sure of the admission criteria prescribed by the Gondwana University. If, for any reason whatsoever, an admission is found to be invalid later on, no fees shall be refunded.

### **C. Attendance :**

A minimum of 80% attendance in theory classes is compulsory. M.Phil. class students shall undertake a Dissertation and the report shall be submitted as per the university direction. Those who do not fulfill the above mentioned requirements may not be eligible to appear in the University examination.

### **REPORTING DATE :-**

The selected candidates shall be informed about the date of reporting and the formalities to be completed within the specified time. The candidates should comply with the same failing which their claim for admission shall stand cancelled. The students are expected to attend the classes from the date notified.

### **EXAMINATION :-**

The M.Phil. examination will be conducted by Gondwana University Gadchiroli once in a year after the end of the session. The theory examination and dissertation shall be treated as separate heads of passing, If the candidate fails to clear the M.Phil theory papers, but passes in the dissertation, he may appear again for the theory examination as a repeater, while the result of the dissertation could be carried forward.

### **College terms & Vacation :-**

As per direction given by the Gondwana University Gadchiroli.



### Assignments:

The students are required to submit their assignments with the concerned teacher within the stipulated time.

Following steps would be taken in case of low attendance percentage.

- A) A Warning letter will be issued to the Students having attendance less than 80%
- B) A letter of communication regarding attendance status of their ward will be dispatched, to the parents/guardians whose attendance is less than 80% and they may be called to discuss the matter personally with the authorities.
- C) In case of students having attendance below 80% may be liable for strict Action to be decided by Head of the Institution.

### DISSERTATION :

A minimum of 20 Research Conferences with the research guide are compulsory.

A diary of the Research Conferences/work done must be maintained regularly the students and the same must be duly signed by their respective Research Guides.

The last date of submission of dissertation with the college office is 20 February. No dissertation submitted thereafter will be accepted by the college.

The cover page and the format of the dissertation must be as per the specifications given by the college or university guideline.

Further detailed specifications are mentioned in the respective syllabus.





### **LIBRARY :-**

1. During the class hours, students must not engage themselves in any other college activities, without the prior written permission of principal in charge of the concerned activity. In the absence of a teacher, Students may avail the facilities of the library with the permission of the Librarian.

All Library rules must be strictly followed by the students. Library shall be open for external students and Research Scholars only on Thursday & Friday.

The above facility can be availed only after completing the necessary formalities.

As a special facility, during the Examination period students are given books against a monetary deposit. (Book Bank Scheme)

### **GENERAL :-**

1. Students must maintain decency and decorum within the college premises
2. Standing in the corridors is strictly prohibited while classes are being engaged.
3. As per the guidelines provided by the Gondwana University Gadchiroli, the Theory and research attendance will be maintained separately and regularly in each is essential.

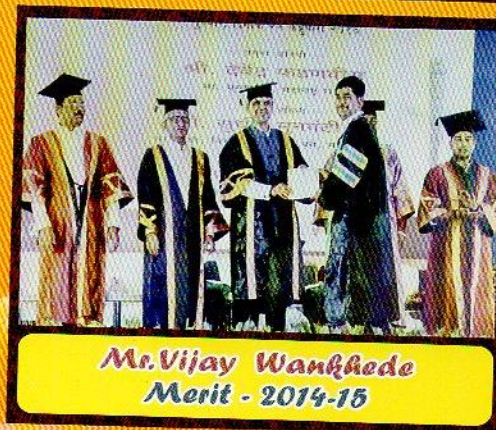
### MISSION AND VISION :-
